Message from the CADA Board Chair

On behalf of the Committee Against Domestic Abuse (CADA) staff and the board members, I would like to thank everyone who has helped to fund, promote or serve CADA in any way during these past two years. Community and regional support of an organization is vital in fulfilling its mission. During 2012 and 2013, CADA has been involved with many initiatives of which I would like to highlight:

- **Crime Victim Services:** In 2012, CADA sought and received funding from the Federal Office of Justice Programs to expand services in the area of sexual violence advocacy. This expanded CADA's role in the region to encompass both domestic and sexual violence services.
- **Blue Print for Safety:** Follow through and completion of the program to bring together all components of the local justice system in an effort to positively intervene in providing domestic abuse services.
- **MENding Project:** Initiation of a program designed to bring men together in an effort to help alleviate the harm of domestic violence through offers of services, money, and time to combat domestic violence.
- **CADA Pets:** Providing services to victims of domestic violence to assist in sheltering their pets during their time of transition.
- **In-House Therapeutic Counseling:** Providing therapy sessions and support groups to victims who are the subject of domestic and sexual violence.
- **Children's Advocacy:** To give children who are victims of domestic violence an opportunity to have support and assistance as a portion of the family unit.
- **Northern Tier Anti-Trafficking Consortium (NTAC):** CADA began offering services to victims of sex trafficking, which has introduced another level of additional support.
- **SART Program Continuation:** CADA has been a continual driving force in making sure victims of sexual violence are provided services upon report of the incident through medical and enforcement efforts.

Lastly, I would like to make a special thank you to The First Christian Church, Hickory Tech Foundation, Scheels, Verizon Wireless, Target and Sears who within our region have committed funds, in-kind services, or time and effort in assisting CADA in serving our clients. Without this and others in our area we would not be able to reach out to victims/survivors of domestic violence and sexual violence.

Program highlights in the fiscal year of 2012

1,305 survivors of domestic violence were served through our Outreach programs * 160 primary and 66 secondary sexual violence victims were served through our Outreach programs * 148 victims of domestic violence were assisted in obtaining Orders For Protection * 82 victims of domestic violence were assisted in obtaining Harassment Restraining Orders * 86 primary and 49 secondary victims of sexual violence were provided with legal advocacy * 59 women and 32 children were provided with emergency safety shelter * 61 children were able to visit with their non-custodial parents through the Keep Me Safe Parenting Time Center * 106 community presentations were facilitated by CADA with 6,710 participants in attendance * 1,566 hours of volunteering/ interning helped us meet our mission *

Program highlights in the fiscal year of 2013

2,139 survivors of domestic violence were served through our Outreach programs * 214 primary and 131 secondary sexual violence victims were served through our Outreach programs * 195 victims of domestic violence were assisted in obtaining Orders For Protection * 95 victims of domestic violence were assisted in obtaining Harassment Restraining Orders * 281 primary and 191 secondary victims of sexual violence were provided with legal advocacy * 90 women and 126 children were provided with emergency safety shelter * 76 children were able to visit with their non-custodial parents through the Keep Me Safe Parenting Time Center * 169 community presentations were facilitated by CADA with 5,957 participants in attendance * 927 hours of volunteering/ interning helped us meet our mission * Survivors of domestic and sexual violence accessed therapeutic counseling 91 times.
